**THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF A1250 (LINK ROAD/THE CAUSEWAY),
BISHOPS STORTFORD DURING THE 'BISHOPS STORTFORD REMEMBRANCE DAY PARADE')
ORDER 2025**

The Hertfordshire County Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (Temporary Closing of A1250 (Link Road/The Causeway), Bishops Stortford during the 'Bishops Stortford Remembrance Day Parade') Order 2025" and shall come into operation between the hours of 10.30am and 12.30pm on Sunday 9 November 2025, when signs are in place.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to Fire and Rescue, Police and Ambulance Service vehicles during the course of an emergency.
3. All vehicular traffic is prohibited from using that length of A1250 (Link Road/The Causeway), Bishops Stortford from a point 72 metres east of its junction with the A1250 Hadham Road/B1004 Northgate End roundabout south eastwards, south westwards and south eastwards to its junction with the A1059 Dane Street roundabout, a distance of approximately 490 metres.

An alternative route will be via A1250 (Link Road/Hadham Road), A1184 (Bishops Park Way/St James Way), B1383 (Thorley Street/London Road), A1060 London Road and A1250 Hockerill Street.

4. In making this Order, Hertfordshire County Council is satisfied that all vehicular traffic should be prohibited from using the above length of road to ensure public safety and prevent accidents whilst the 'Bishops Stortford Remembrance Day Parade' takes place.
